- Clovis West Boys- Won a high School tournament in L.A. beating a team ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> nationally. The C.W. boys are now ranked in the Nation's top 10.
- CIF Rule- Discussion about the possibility of CIF rule restricting Club players from playing in High School being extended to the Junior High ranks. This rule would have major impact on all Clovis Junior High teams. This rule is not yet in effect, only in the discussion stages.
