It was moved by John Gross and seconded by John Vincent to approve the Oct 2007 meeting minutes. The motion passed.

Correspondence: (Attachment A) A proposed resolution has been reached with Clovis Unified regarding Clovis players playing in Junior High. This will not apply to players playing club ball outside of Clovis.

Treasurer's Report: (Attachment B)

Statements were distributed. Some clubs still owe money. 473 people attended Soccer Night in Fresno with the Falcons. Clovis Elem. Was the top ticket seller with 138 tickets sold.

Referees Report: (Attachment C)

District 7 Report: There was a decent turn-out for McValley Cup. The District Playing League is having problems getting game cards turned in, Odyssey will work to improve this. Referee registration is ongoing for 2008. ODP tryouts will start in May.

Competition Committee: Please turn in game cards by Saturday night. Minor errors in the standings are being reviewed. Team movement is still ongoing.

Old Business:

All-Star Coaches- Only 5 coaches have applied for 24 teams. Player nominations are due by Nov. 15th. Any club wanting to host District All-Star games must notify Mike, hosting applications are due at D7 by Nov 30th.

Thanksgiving Tournament- Nov 11th is the deadline for applications. 50 teams are required or the tournament will be canceled. No inter-club transfers will be allowed for this tournament, all player transfers must be within the same club. All player transfer forms must be in the office by Sunday the 18th at 5pm.

Picture Make Ups- Nov. 10th from 2-4pm. Only 8 teams did not get their pictures taken. Individual re-takes are welcome. Photos will be at Garfield.

Clovis Elementary Loan Request- Clovis' revised request is for \$2500.

It was moved by Brian Zegarrelli and seconded by John Shelton to loan Clovis the \$2500 needed for the purchase of new uniforms. The loan must be paid back within 1 calendar year from the date of the check. The motion passed.

New Business:

Lights- Monday & Wednesday's Buchanan, Clovis East & Bicentennial are to be considered parks. There will be no assigned fields on these nights, first come first served. Teams only can have nets.
