Minutes:

Referee's Reports: The major complaint this season is the inconsistencies in the referees calls. Some sites will have different seniors next season.

Bingo: Tuesday nights at the Clovis Bingo Hall. We expect to be very profitable in the next few months. We average 20 volunteers per week, 187 players per night.

District 7: Commissioners Cup deadline tomorrow. Our teams represented well in the District Playing Leagues.

Risk Management: The PAD committee will be convening. Coaches dismissed at Thanksgiving Tournament will have their penalties carry over till next year.

Old Business:

Season Wrap: Next year it is probable that we will have game cards for U8's. We will have a look at re-vamping schedules to an automatic promotion/relegation system.
