

## **Minutes from the CJSL Annual General Meeting**

**February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

**Call to order:** 7:04

**Roll Call:** Attendance taken by the three Vice Presidents at the door.

**Minutes:** Minutes from the 2015 AGM were ratified at the March 2015 and are available online.

**Presidents Report:** The last two years have gone well. Three goals for the upcoming year; improving coaches education, Crossfire & FC Clovis involvement with the rec clubs, Rebuilding the TOPSoccer program.

**Blue VP Report:** Thanks to the commissioners who participated with the Admin. Committee. Also looking to get more clubs participating with the Admin Committee.

**Red VP Report:** Competition Committee went very smoothly this year. Thanks to the clubs who participated.

**Gold VP Report:** The PAD Committee had an increase in incidents of poor sportsmanship. John is working on coaches education on the rules of the games and on a sportsmanship mandate for all coaches. Thank you to the commissioners who served on the PAD Committee.

**Registrar's Report:** 4547 players registered, 387 teams, 30 US Club teams registered.

**Treasurer's Report:** (Attachment A) P&L distributed. Over \$97k in net income with two months left in the fiscal year.

**FC Clovis:** 8 teams playing in Spring League. Founders Cup for the older teams starts at the end of February. They had 13 teams registered for Fall League.

**Crossfire:** They have tryouts starting next week. Two younger teams finished in the State Cup Top 10. More teams are still involved in State Cup.

**Director of Coaching:** 80 kids currently participating in the All Star Training Academy. CJSL coaches and players are participating.

**Elections:** It is suggested that since all three candidates are running unopposed that we elect all three as a slate. There is no opposition to this. Results; President- Carmen Saucedo, Treasurer- Elba Gomez, Secretary- Craig Steitz.
