Annual General Meeting Minutes

February 21st, 2013

Call to Order: President Mike Hodges called the meeting to order at 7:09 PM. Attendance recorded by Andrea & Lindsey Lynott and Angie Neathery.

Minutes: 2013 AGM Minutes were approved at the March 2013 B.O.D. Meeting.

Election of Officers: All three V.P.'s & equipment manager up for election. The only position with more than one candidate is the Red VP. The candidates are given five minutes each to address the group & answer any questions prior to the vote.

Diane Resendez- Started as a team mom at Nelson. Grew with her son to a team manager at Cen. Cal. Heat. Eventually became Commissioner at Nelson for several years before becoming Red VP. Has served on the PAD committee & competition committee. Scheduling has continued to improve each year.

Robert Woodley- Has been coaching for several years. Currently fields and equipment manager at FC Clovis. Not running necessarily against Diane but for the Red VP Position.

Votes will be counted and the results posted at the end of the meeting.

President's Report: We are down about 200 kids this year. We had 442 teams this past fall. For the first time in many years we had zero no-shows to games this year. Thanksgiving Tournament hosted 119 teams. All Stars we had the top three U10 Girls teams, top two U12 girls. We expect to have 80 teams in Spring League, down a bit this year.

VP Reports: Red- none, Blue- none, Gold- Proud of the league. We have added the Heat, which came one game short of the playoffs in their first year. Crossfire has grown leaps and bound in three years. Scheduling has continued to improve.

Registrars Report: 5,543 players in the fall season, 421 teams. We are down 139 players from last year, and we have gained one club back.

Treasurer's Report: We ran \$12k in the black this past season.

Competition Committee: Scheduling went very well this year. Schedules were posted online a week early this year.

Crossfire: They are holding to two teams per age group. They are seeing an increase in playing level club wide. Tryouts are going well, and they are seeing an increase in their coaches abilities.
