Old Business:

- Coaches Clinics – A calendar was passed around for sign-ups of available clinic dates & times. Clinics are held in hour sessions, clubs can double up to assure attendance.
- Coaches & Referee License Clinics – All attendees who have registered for clinics please call again to sign up. All contact information was lost in the office computer crash.
- FSU Tailgate – We will need to make contact Fresno State's new coach to confirm dates & times.
- Juniors Program- This item is tabled due to the challenge of the vote allowing the program at last month's meeting. Mike Campbell made a motion to reconsider the vote at last month's meeting, but this motion was not allowed as the issue has been tabled. Mike was assured that this item could be revisited at a later meeting under old business.

New Business:

- Fugman – Janet Reid. A handout was provided (Attachment B) outlining Fugman's strategies & objectives for the upcoming season. A 30 minute discussion was held regarding the problems Fugman is apparently having with coaches/parents at Copper Hills wanting their children to play with teams they have played with in the past. All new clubs go through this issue, and must work with the surrounding clubs to resolve ongoing issues. By consensus, the existing CJSL rules will be enforced. All players registered at Fugman will play at Fugman. Any variations will be handled on a case by case basis. Copper Hills & Riverview have been warned not to hide players during registration.
