Registrar's Report: 97 U6 teams have been registered. Please make sure these teams are co-ed. U6 season starts on Sept. 25th.

Treasurer's Report: All clubs were supposed to pay half or \$5k of registration fees based on last years registration numbers. Many clubs have not paid their account as yet. U6 t-shirts will be available in the office to clubs that have paid their balance.

Referee Report: We have finished our referee clinics for the season. Fresno Metro or Roosevelt may be hosting one more clinic. Anyone interested in refereeing needs to attend that clinic.

Competition Committee: The competition committee will meet Monday Sept. 6th at 7pm in the CJSL Office.

District7: District 7 has pulled all but two teams from the CCSL. District 8 has pulled their teams in support of Dist. 7.

TOPSoccer: The Sept. 24th game at Fresno State is the Special Needs Game. TOPSoccer is still taking registrations. Their season starts on Sept. 11th at Pinedale Elementary.

Risk Management: Club Websites- Clubs need to use every means available to distribute information to their membership. The CJSL office gets calls everyday asking club specific questions we don't have the answer to.

Old Business:

McCarty Soccer Academy- Chad McCarty brought in a plaque as a thank you for our participation with MSA. The camp averaged 85 kids per week. 30 kids received partial or full scholarships, and \$1100 was donated back to host schools.

Make A Difference Day- Can accommodate about 100 teams. All CJSL U6 teams will be invited to participate on Oct. 16th.

Fireworks- Walk up sales were abysmal. Sales were down \$8-9K from last season.

New Business:

Player Swap: A break in the meeting was held so that clubs with excess players could work with clubs short players to find a place for every child to play. All registered players had a place to play at the end of the meeting.

Good of the Game:

FC Clovis started their season last week with no problems.

Central Valley Playing League will have 65-85 teams. A large increase from last year.

Competitive Program: Lemoore Tournament- Fireballs took 3rd place, United took 2nd, and Cyclone took 2nd place.
