California Odyssey Juniors Recreation Soccer

What do you do for the U-10 player with an obvious love of the game and a higher than usual love for training and development?

Answer: Send them to our new CJSL California Odyssey Junior Academy!

CJSL and California Odyssey have created a new fall recreational academy open to higher motivated boys and girls born between 8/1/95 to 7/31/97 (Under 10).

Participation is voluntary and in lieu of team play with our CJSL elementary school based recreational clubs.

Teams are forming first-come first-serve, with balanced strength. There is only one acceptance criteria: is the player committed to age appropriate positive approach academy style training, fun small-sided

games, player development focused league games, and optional festival play? **No tryouts!**

Players train as both teams and consolidated age groups under direct guidance of the professional California Odyssey staff, assisted by parent assistant coaches/managers.

Player development and enjoyment are emphasized. Players are challenged in training to master detailed age specific curriculum necessary for maximum potential future development. Game play is for **player** fun, with adults measuring success only on the basis of player improvement.

We begin drop-off free play small sided games in July, training in August, and league play throughout September and November.
